*Picnic Shares***1** one half**2** one third**3** one fourth**4** two fourths**5** two thirds**6** one half**7** three fourths**8** four eighths**9** two halves**10** three thirds**11** four fourths**12** two thirds

13 ★ Not fair — the 3 pieces are different sizes, so they are not thirds. Equal parts is what makes a fraction.

Tip: items 9, 10, and 11 shade EVERY part — that's on purpose. "Two halves," "three thirds," and "four fourths" each mean one whole, and saying so out loud is the aha moment of this sheet. And the boss sandwich: three pieces only make thirds when the pieces match.
