***Inch Specimens*****1** Thumper Beetle — 3 inches**2** Royal Dragonfly — 5 inches**3** Big Red Ant — 2 inches**4** Meadow Grasshopper — 4 inches**5** Sunwing Butterfly — 5 inches**6** Dotted Ladybug — 3 inches***Centimeter Specimens*****7** Zigzag Inchworm — 6 centimeters**8** Jade Beetle — 4 centimeters**9** Walking Stick — 8 centimeters**10** Ribbon Dragonfly — 9 centimeters**11** Speedy Hopper — 7 centimeters**12** ★ Little Ladybug — 5 centimeters

*Tip: the bugs that don't start at zero are the whole point of this sheet — a child who reads the number under the tail instead of counting nose to tail has found the classic trap. Ask: "where does the bug start?" Real scientists measure from the nose, not from zero.*
