Tip: borrowing is just the bakery sheet in reverse – there, ten loose cookies became one box; here, one bundle becomes ten loose balloons. Ask "can the ones give enough?" first. If not, the untying ritual: cross out the tens digit, write one less, give the ones their ten. The crossed-out digit isn't a mistake – it's a receipt.
